

# **Lost Valley Prairie Scientific and Natural Area September Adopt-A-Knob Work Day**

September is the prime late season seed collecting time. The seed of summer blooming forbs will be ready. There will be many species to collect. Additionally some of the grasses may be ready as well. Drop seed, Indian grass, big blue stem, little blue stem will be at the cusp of ripening as well.

There will be a number of fall blooming forbs especially the asters so this work day will continue our work from August of identifying plants on the Fish Knob. Plant type, location, and density information will again be collected for the plants now in bloom.

If we want to, we can also start cutting brush, stacking it and creating brush piles for the winter burn season.

Wear sturdy boots, dress for the weather. Leather gloves will be helpful.  
Bring a lunch and water. We will be eating out on the knob.
